KRUGER NATIONAL *Park*

Situated 2km from the iconic Kruger National Park, Bush Villas on Kruger is your gateway to the untamed wonders of the African wilderness. THE PANORAMA *Route*

Renowned for its breathtaking landscapes, dramatic viewpoints, and natural attractions, the Panorama Route offers visitors an opportunity to witness some of South Africa's most spectacular scenery.

THE BLYDE RIVER CANYON

The third-largest canyon in the world, this is the main attraction along the Panorama Route, offering awe-inspiring views of steep cliffs, lush vegetation, and the winding Blyde River below. The canyon is particularly renowned for its Three Rondavels, three large rock formations resembling traditional African huts.

GOD'S WINDOW

A viewpoint situated on the edge of the Drakensberg escarpment, offering panoramic vistas of the Lowveld landscape below. On clear days, visitors can see as far as Mozambique.



BOURKE'S LUCK POTHOLES

A geological marvel where the Blyde and Treur Rivers converge, forming cylindrical potholes in the rock over thousands of years. Visitors can explore the area via walkways and bridges, marveling at the unique formations and the power of water erosion.

THE PINNACLE ROCK

A striking quartzite rock formation rising vertically out of the forest, resembling a towering spire. It's a popular stop along the route for its unique geological features.

WATERFALLS

The Panorama Route is dotted with several picturesque waterfalls, including Lisbon Falls, Berlin Falls, and Mac-Mac Falls. These cascades offer refreshing stops amidst the scenic beauty of the region.

GRASKOP GORGE

Whether you're interested in scenic views, outdoor exploration, or thrilling experiences, there's something for everyone to enjoy at Graskop Gorge: The Gorge Lift provides visitors with a stunning panoramic view as they descend into the lush indigenous forest below. It's a thrilling experience that offers a different perspective of the gorge's natural beauty.



MAGOEBAS *Kloof*

Magoebaskloof is not to be missed. The route is breathtakingly beautiful and will take you along winding mountainous roads and incredible sights and attractions.

Also known as “The Land of the Silver Mist”, the mountains and valleys of the area are regularly shrouded in a soft mist. Historically, this mist belt has created lush afro-montane forests in the river lines.

Pay a visit to the Debengeni Waterfalls or visit the quaint little town of Haenertsburg.

The area offers a variety of outdoor activities for visitors to enjoy, including hiking, mountain biking, birdwatching, and picnicking. The Magoebaskloof Canopy Tour is a popular attraction, allowing visitors to zip-line through the forest canopy and experience the area's beauty from a unique perspective.

MOHOLOHOLO REHABILITATION *Centre*



Situated near Hoedspruit, the center focuses on the rehabilitation and care of injured, abandoned, and poisoned wildlife with the aim of releasing them back into their natural habitats.

They offer educational programs and guided tours for visitors, providing insight into the challenges facing South Africa's wildlife and what can be done to help. Two tours daily from Monday – Saturday, approximate duration of the tour is 1.5 to 2 hours long.

There is also a museum, curio shop and tuck shop on site.

A visit to the Centre is an experience of a lifetime and will leave you with lasting memories.
